**BRIEF HISTORY
OF
CORNWALL CLUB'S FOUNDATION**

For many years it has been felt that there was a definite need for a Rotary Club in the City of Cornwall. With the chartering of the Massena Club a year ago, the Ideals of Rotary were brought so near that it was only natural to expect that they would be transmitted across the border. Such was the case when in October the original contacts were made. Immediately it was apparent that the business and professional men of Cornwall were aware of the desirability of the formation of a Rotary Club.

Thus it was, after several visits and many communications, that on November 23rd it was voted by a group in Cornwall to organize themselves as a provisional club and apply for a charter from Rotary International.

The provisional club's first luncheon meeting was held in the King George Hotel on Monday, November 27th.

It was not by chance that December 13th was selected as the date for charter night. Rather it was part of a long range plan that the charter night be on the first anniversary of the sponsoring club, thereby enabling an international exchange of Charter Night celebrations in the future.
