ROTARY PRESIDENT TO VISIT SAVANNAH

INTERNATIONAL CHIEF TO SPEAK AT NEXT WEEK'S MEETING

Savannah's Rotary Club will be officially visited at next Monday's meeting by Arthur Lagueux of Quebec City, president of Rotary International.

Every club in Rotary District 241, of which the local club is a part, will send representatives to the luncheon meeting, at which Mr. Lagueux will speak.

Dr. Reginald Maxwell of Augusta, governor of the district, will introduce Mr. Lagueux. Among the guests will be Porter Carswell of Waynesboro, an international director of Rotary.

Mr. and Mrs. Lagueux will arrive in Savannah at 7:15 Sunday evening. They will leave the same time Monday evening for St. Petersburg, Fla.

The president of Rotary International has been a member of the Quebec Club since 1934, and has served as president of that club, as director of Rotary International and as district governor.

Mr. Lagueux is president of the investment corporation of Lagueux and DesRochers in Quebec City, president of the LaSarre Power Company of LaSarre, Quebec, president of the Financial building in Quebec City and is a director of the Commonwealth International Corporation and of the Leverage Fund of Canada, Ltd.

He is also vice president of the Bond Dealers' Association in Quebec City, and chairman of the Re-establishment Credit Advisory Committee of the Canadian Department of Veterans' Affairs. He is an officer of the Order of the British Empire.

J. Phil Schenck is president of the Savannah Club. Joseph Mendel and Hue Thomas, Jr., are general program chairmen for the meeting which will be attended by Mr. Lagueux, and Edwin B. McCuen is

hospitality chairman, to assist Mr. and Mrs. Lagueux while they are in Savannah.
